On-Campus Property

Any student housing facility that is owned or controlled by the institution or is located on property that is owned or controlled by the institution and is within the reasonably contiguous geographic area that makes up campus.

CLERY GEOGRAPHY

Any building or property owned or

controlled by WVU within the same

reasonably contiguous geographic

area and either used by WVU in direct

Non-Campus Property

Any building or property owned or controlled by WVU that is frequently used by students and is not within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution, or any property that is owned or controlled by an officially recognized student organization.

Public Property

Property located either within, immediately adjacent to or accessible from campus. This includes thoroughfares, streets, sidewalks and parking facilities that are either within, immediately adjacent to or accessible from campus.

ALERT SYSTEMS

WVU Alert (Emergency Notification)

These notifications are issued for significant emergencies or dangerous situations, such as an active shooter, bomb threat or explosion. Emergency notifications also can be issued for incidents that aren't crimes, such as a gas leak or a nearby chemical or hazardous waste spill.

Campus Warning (Timely Warning)

These notifications are reported in a timely manner once all pertinent information is available. They are reserved for Clery crimes within Clery geography that pose an ongoing threat to the campus community.

Community Notice

These notifications are not required by the Clery Act and are issued at the discretion of the University. Community Notices help enhance safety, and the originating incident does not need to occur on campus.
